Storage Box policy for CCHS Members

- 1. Personal (non-club) projects, parts and tools left at the CCHS must be **in** your storage tub unless some other arrangement has been made with the committee (See point 11). Storage racks must not be used for items that don't fit into CCHS member's storage tub.
- 2. CCHS members who are up to date with their fees are eligible for a standard black 50 litre tub on the storage racks near the side entrance.
- 3. Since storage space is limited, CCHS members are not guaranteed a storage tub. Personal storage tubs must only be located on the storage racks and not on general shelves, under workbenches, etc.
- 4. Standard sized storage tubs are purchased by CCHS. This is not a B.Y.O storage tub scheme.
- 5. One CCHS member, one storage tub.
- 6. Allocation of an existing (pre-loved) storage tub costs \$15 and includes a \$10 deposit. If all existing storage tubs have been allocated and a new storage tub needs to be purchased (by the CCHS), then allocation costs \$20 ... provided there is room on the storage racks.
- 7. Storage tubs must be clearly labelled on the front with the member's name. Kudos for avant-garde labels ... that don't damage the storage tub.
- 8. Please be considerate and release your storage tub back into the pool if you aren't using it.

 Pro-actively returning your storage tub to the unallocated pool means you get your \$10 deposit back.
- 9. If a member lapses on their dues they have 1 month to renew before their tub goes back into the unallocated pool. The member will be requested to empty their tub and their deposit will be returned to them when that has been completed. If they do not promptly comply, their tub will be emptied for them and their deposit is forfeit.
- 10. A member's storage tub and deposit will be forfeited if ...
 - a. The member is consistently late with their dues.
 - b. The member stores materials that may corrode, explode or cause unreasonable damage.
 - c. The member is storing illegal material. This is not allowed by the CCHS Rules Of Association and will need to be dealt with via the RoA and reported to the police.
 - d. At the discretion of the committee. For example, the member breaching the RoA, the Member Rules or the After Hours Key Access Policy.
 - e. The storage tub is damaged.
- 11. Prearrangements with the committee ...
 - a. CCHS group projects: Projects that benefit the space, members or the community in general. These projects will not be stored in the member area. e.g Garduino (gardening).
 - b. Several member boxes that have been grandfathered into this scheme. They are owned by members, but still fall under policy. Over time, these boxes will be gradually replaced with standard black storage tubs.
